## 5. Norms followed for fixing fee:



### THE HYDERABAD PUBLIC SCHOOL® Ramanthapur, Hyderabad

#### Criteria for fixing fee structure as per GO.Ms.No.1 dated 01.01.1994 amended up to 15.07.2009.

The Governing Body is empowered to prescribe the fee structure. While fixing the fee structure, the Governing Body takes in to account the following:


- a) Expenditure involving payment of salaries and other benefits to the staff;
- b) Expenditure involving Electricity and Water charges.
- c) Expenditure involving office requirement like stationery, stamps etc.
- d) Expenditure involving class room needs like chalk, dusters etc.
- e) Expenditure involving purchase of books for the library, chemicals and specimens for the laboratory.
- f) Expenditure involving payments to the Auditors engaged for auditing the accounts.
- g) Expenditure on contribution towards Education cess.
- h) Any other miscellaneous expenditure.

The fee collected from the students shall be allocated as to meet the following requirements:

- 1) 5 % of the fees collected shall be earmarked as corpus fund for future development.
- 2) 15 % of the fees collected shall be utilized for the maintenance of the institution towards the expenditure like building rent, electricity and water charges, stationary, etc.
- 3) 15 % of the fees collected shall be earmarked for the development activities of the institution i.e. Expenditure involving additional courses, classes and construction of additional accommodations, etc.
- 4) 50 % of the fees collected shall be earmarked towards payment of salaries for the staff.
- 5) 15 % of the fees collected shall be earmarked as management's contribution towards staff benefits like gratuity, teachers provident fund, Group insurance scheme, etc.

1	That <u>The Hyderabad Public School Society (Regd.)</u> is a registered Society under the Hyderabad Public Societies Act (Act 1 of 1350 F) by Registration No.18/1951 dt. 18 <sup>th</sup> September, 1951.
2	That <u>The Hyderabad Public School Society (Regd.)</u> is of Non-Proprietary Character.
3	That the school is being run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any manner whatsoever.
4	That no part of income from the Institution is being and will be diverted to any individual in the Trust/Society/Company/School Management Committee or to any other person/entity. The saving, if any, after meeting the recurring and nonrecurring expenditure and contributions to developmental, Depreciation and contingency funds, will be further utilized for promoting the school and extending the cause of education in the same school only.

- 5 That school is not paying any charges towards using name, motto, logo or any other non-academic activities to any other institution, organization or body.
- 6 That the school will not open classes under CBSE pattern particularly class IX/X/XI/XII and will not use CBSE name in any manner without obtaining affiliation.
- 7 That the Principal and Correspondent/Manager of the school have individually gone through the provisions contained in the affiliation & examination byelaws and the circulars issued by the Board from time to time. The school undertakes to abide by the provisions contained in the affiliation & examination byelaws, directions issued from time to time and the law of the land.
- 8 That the school will ensure compliance of all statutory requirements like EPF, ESI and Labor Laws etc. with respect to the school and staff of the school.
- 9 That the school will ensure that the Building Safety, Fire Safety, Water Safety, Health and Hygiene certificates are being issued or renewed by the concerned municipal or state authorities from time to time as per the prescribed term.

**Solar Project:** HPS is going green by not only with its lush green campus but also solar energy as well.

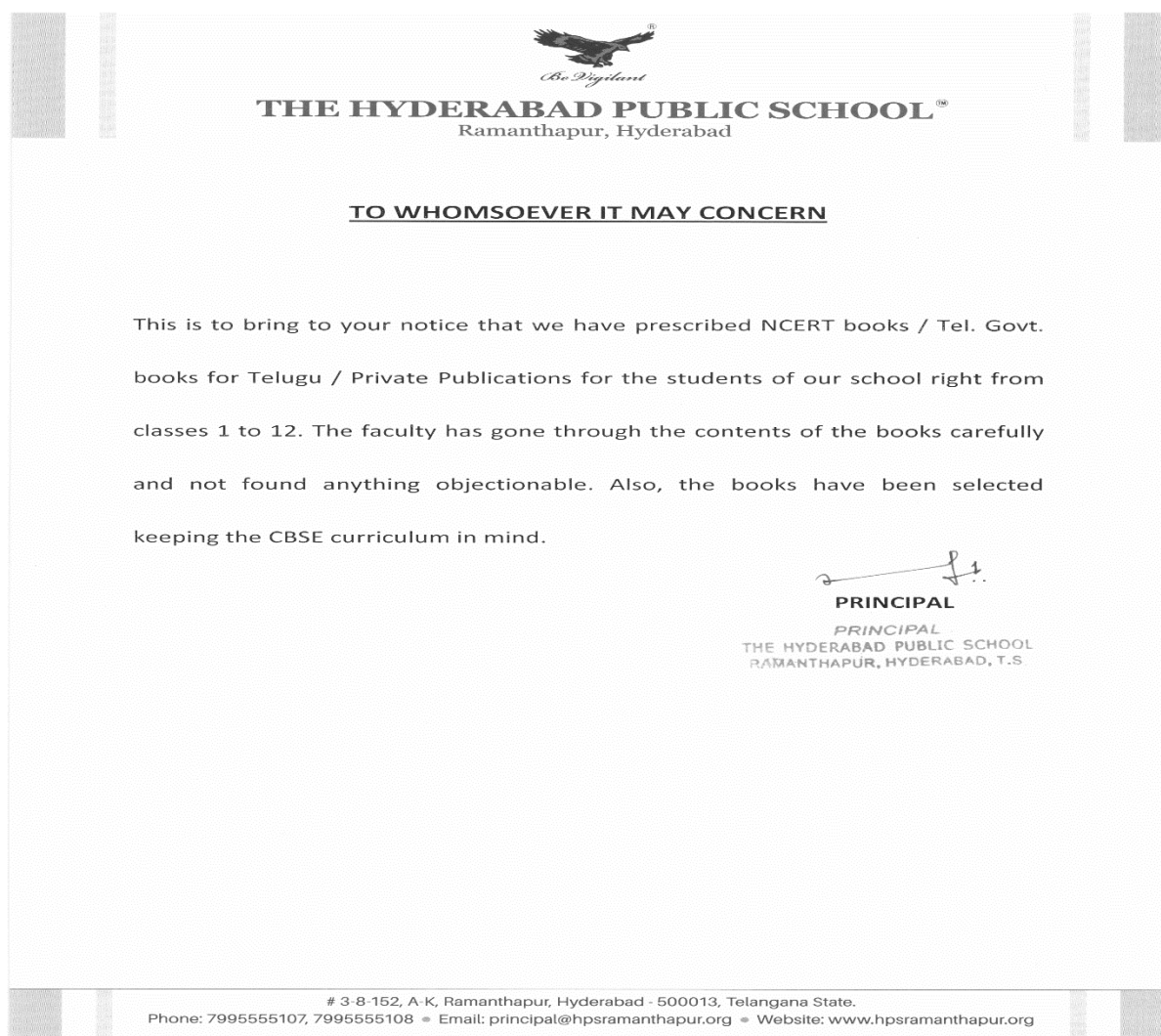
**Kitchen hood system:** Now, Our kitchen is equipped with hood system with which temperature and moisture levels are under control thereby it becomes comfortable to work
